Music Notes from Ronn Lowe: Georg P. Telemann (1681-1767) was considered by his contemporaries to be one of the leading German composers of the time. He was compared favorably to his friend Johann Sebastian Bach, who made Telemann the godfather and namesake of his son Carl Philipp Emanuel, and to George Frideric Handel, whom Telemann also knew personally. Jean-François Taillard is a very active musical arranger, providing arrangements for diverse brass or chamber ensembles, as well as renowned orchestras such as the Baltimore Symphony, the Rundfunk-Symphonie-Orchester Berlin, the Bolshoi Orchestra, the Vienna Philharmonic Orchestra, the Kammerorchester Basel, the Cappella Gabetta, and the Sinfonieorchester Basel.
